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訪問許鞍華導演

今年，本校十分榮幸，邀請到許鞍華導演作為畢業禮的主禮嘉賓。我們更有幸於典禮後與許導演進行了簡短的訪問：

- 記 我們知道你在香港唸的是英國文學和比較文學，後來為何會去英國唸電影呢？
許 其實唸文學是很痛苦的，特別是寫論文的時候，尤其覺得苦悶。所以那時候我便常常和同學走去
看電影，並且產生了興趣。畢業後，聽說英國有電影學校，便去修讀了。
- 記 在電影學校唸書時有特別難忘的經歷嗎？
許 特別辛苦啊！我對科技產品的應用是很笨的，總是不懂得操作攝影機。當時的功課是以小組形式
完成，所以我的同學每天都要幫我補習，教我怎樣操作攝影機。不過，能夠親身體驗拍攝的過程，
真的很有趣。
- 記 電影《桃姐》贏得多項大獎，蜚聲國際，這個以老人為主題的故事在影視界十分罕有，是如何取
得靈感的？
許 我一直想開拍一部簡單而樸實的電影，但苦無具體故事，也沒有題材。一次偶然機會下，朋友為
我提供了他和老僕人的故事，我覺得這個闡述主僕和人際關係的故事挺有意思，便採用了。
電影中很多關於老人院的情節都是真實的。例如老伯伯和別的院友調換了假牙的情節，不但好笑，
也反映了現實的生活面貌。我希望觀眾能透過電影看到真實的社會狀況。在電影中加入這些笑位，
也可以達到雅俗共賞的效果。
- 記 有沒有考慮過拍攝以青少年為主題的電影作為新的嘗試？
許 我曾經有過這個念頭。不過，以中學生作為演員始終有一定的困難，拍攝時間比較難安排和配合。
你以前也曾在演藝學院和大學執教，將來會有這方面的打算嗎？
許 我以前曾經教過書，不過我覺得還是拍電影比較適合我。也許當我年老，不能再拍電影了，就會
跑去教書。



訪問時，許導演率直爽快地回答問題，令我們戰戰兢兢的心情放鬆下來。期間，她提及年輕時曾和朋友一起去算命，算命先生批她命苦，一生勞碌。面對這句令人不甚愉快的批語，她仍能處之泰然，何解？

「我覺得每個人的準則不同。其實命好不好，還是要看看自己的價值觀，用甚麼標準去量度。算命先生可能認為一生勞碌是命苦，在他而言，不用工作才是好事，但是，對我來說，一生勞碌卻是對自己的挑戰，讓我從工作中獲得快樂和滿足。」

「對於別人的批評，我不會耿耿於懷，反而會自我反省。如果言之有理，便會接納意見，予以改善。」

許導演在畢業致辭中勉勵同學要「認識自己」、「活到老，學到老」。她全情投入熱愛的工作，不斷從生活和工作中認識自我，這種積極而樂觀的態度，正是她的人生觀的最佳寫照。

English Funfair 2012



On Saturday 14th April, Liu Po Shan Memorial College held the annual English Funfair. The English department began planning for the event months in advance, filling the undercover playground and rooms G02 and G03 with numerous games stalls. Students from LPS, teachers, primary students, and parents attended the Funfair and enjoyed the opportunity to play games, eat snacks, and practise English. Students from LPS and visiting primary students were each given a ticket to collect stamps. Stamps were earned by participating in as many events as possible, with a maximum of 22 points.

The weather was looking bleak all week, but luckily on the day the sun was shining and it put everyone in a great mood for the Funfair. English teachers helped to design the games and ensured that students were participating and practising English. The LPS students were primarily in charge of managing the event and running the game stalls. A popular game was Chatter Box. Students would be given a category such as sport, food or countries. The students would then have to pick up a card with a letter on it and say a word suitable to that category. In addition to the games the teachers developed, there was a large selection of games provided by the Chatteris Educational Foundation. Some of these games included Soft Ball Attack, Save the Animals, Star Shot, Animal Darts and Ball Pit Grab. The 'Shooting' game was a very popular game that involved students reading aloud a sequence of animals, and then attempting to shoot their picture with a toy gun.

Another popular event at the Funfair was face painting. Many students from different classes led the face painting booth and encouraged students to speak English while they painted creative and colorful patterns on their faces and arms. Even the Principal got involved and had a beautiful butterfly painted on her arm.

Halfway through the Funfair, students went to the hall where the English Drama Club put on their performance of "Yesterday Once More." The play was entertaining and amusing telling the story of two brothers and two sisters who did not excel in their school work or extra curriculum activities. They soon see what their life would like in the future if they do not change their ways. The play was humorous and delightful and all of the audience thoroughly enjoyed the performance.

The Funfair finished at 12:30. At this time students rushed to hand in their score tickets and collect their prizes. All prizes were given a value based on the number of stamps students collected. There was a selection of great prizes, big and small and students could win, cute teddies, toy guns, and lots of key chains and bags.

This year's English Funfair was a huge success. The students had a great time and many primary students were enthusiastic about the games and the show. The student helpers spoke lots of English and encouraged the guests to do the same. It was a great success and fun was had by all the staff, students and guests.
