於這次的活動中，陳師兄幫助我們更深入地了解工程師這種職業，並教導我們如何待人處事。從最初的手忙腳亂到最後完成報告，除了必須努力學習陌生的專業知識外，也需要大家團結一致，互相協調。

我們以「土地供應」為題進行探究，內容涵蓋香港土地的規劃、效益、供應量不足及市民期望四個範疇。在研究這些問題的同時，我們還提出解決方案，包括開岩洞、填海（人工島）、設計立體建築群和樂高式可移動海上漂浮城市。我們認為這些方案都有著「智能城市」的特質，而且可以充分發揮香港人的獅子山精神。
